

Purpose

Black/African American families in San Francisco who are homeless or at-risk for homelessness and the Black providers serving this community are in urgent need of healing and support. Nearly 50% of SF's homeless adults with children are Black/African American, though only around 5% of the city's population is Black.

HCN will focus on targeting marginalized Black community members most in need of support—i Black/African American individuals who are homeless, at-risk for homeless, or providers working within SF's homeless and shelter system.

About HCN

The mission of the Homeless Children Network (HCN) has always been to make marginalized voices heard in order for them to become more stable, confident, and supported.

Since 1992, we have provided security and stability to the most underserved families in San Francisco, including those experiencing homelessness and domestic abuse trauma.

As HCN expands as the hub of a 52-member collaborative, we look for new ways to raise and unite marginalized voices.

HCN's <u>Community Innovations Mini - Grants Program</u> is looking to help Black/African American individuals who are homeless, at-risk for homelessness, and Black providers who support Black homeless families or those at-risk of homelessness, in San Francisco, with Mini-Grants valued between (\$500 - \$5,000!)*

How to apply

- 1. Share your vision with us by phone or in-person.
- 2. Complete the written application.
- 3. Complete a brief interview with the Community Innovations Mini Grantors.
- 4. Community members and Community Innovations Mini Grantors, will make a decisior within 48 hours. If the application is approved, the check process will begin according to the grant agreement.
